

WeeFIM Functional Improvement Quality Measures ¹

Multiple metrics are used to determine a child's improvement throughout their inpatient stay. Patients are scored on their admission and again at discharge in the categories of Self-Care, Mobility, and Cognition, which includes multiple skills and abilities as shown in the graphic below. The improvements are measured by the change in score and can be compared with similar facilities. **Higher scores are better.**

Self-Care


Eating, Grooming, Oral hygiene Toilet hygiene, Bathing/Showering Upper body dressing, Lower body dressing


Comprehension, Expression Social interaction Problem-Solving, Memory



Therapy services are provided at a minimum of 15 hours per week (900 minutes over a rolling 7-day week from admission). All patients receive 24-hour physician & rehab nursing care.



Discharge to Home/Community

Spaulding Rehabilitation Hospital Boston (SRH) discharges pediatric patients back to home at a rate below other similar facilities.



The other 20% of pediatric patients required additional medical care and were sent to an acute facility prior to being discharged to the community. A number of these patients were readmitted to SRH to continue their rehabilitation care.
