



SCC provides expert care for multiple Rehabilitation Impairment Categories.



Functional Improvement Quality Measures ¹

Multiple metrics are used to determine patient improvement throughout their inpatient stay. Patients are scored on their admission and again at discharge in the categories of Self-Care and Mobility, which includes multiple skills and abilities as shown in the graphic below. The improvements are measured by the change in score for both and can be compared with similar rehabilitation facilities. **Higher scores are better.**


Self-Care

- Eating
- Oral hygiene
- Toilet hygiene
- Shower/bathe self
- Upper body dress
- Lower body dress
- Applying footwear


Mobility

- Rolling, lying down and sitting up in bed
- Sit to stand
- Transferring to and from bed and chair
- Transferring to and from toilet
- Transferring in and out of car
- Ambulation (walking)
- Climbing stairs
- Retrieval of item from ground
- Wheelchair mobility

Therapy services are provided at a minimum of 15 hours per week (900 minutes over a rolling 7 day week from admission). All patients receive 24 hour physician & rehab nursing care.


Patient Experience ^{2,3}


91% of patients would **highly recommend** Spaulding Cape Cod to friends and family.



SCC scores above benchmark for all of the of the following survey questions related to quality of care for our patients on post-discharge surveys provided by NRC Health.


How likely would you be to recommend this facility to your family and friends?

The number of patients who would recommend SCC is in the 99th percentile of all Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities that use NRC Health.




Did the care team prepare you and your family for discharge?

The number of patients and families that felt SCC prepared them for discharge is in the 97th percentile of all Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities that use NRC Health.




Was there good communication between the different clinicians?

The number of patients who agreed there was good communication between staff at SCC is in the 89th percentile of all Inpatient Rehabilitation Facilities that use NRC Health.




Did the nurses treat you with courtesy and respect?


Did the therapist explain things in a way you could understand?






Discharge to Home/Community

SCC discharges patients back to home at a rate **comparable** to other similar facilities in the region.




Getting Started Sooner

SCC admits patients on average 1-2 days **earlier** from the initial diagnosis than the region/nation. This means you or your loved one can start rehabilitation and take advantage of this critical period for recovery.




Age Groups Served
